The home sits on a compact 620m² block, on the lower side of York St. There's enough slope to provide a view without compromising the large back yard. The slope provides plenty of under building storage too!

Externally, the house is HardiPlank clad with a carport under the roofline. From here you enter a split-level home with cathedral ceilings on the lower level. The ceilings are timber lined with exposed beams, the floors are polished timber. The lounge area is air conditioned while the kitchen has electric cooking and a great outlook over the rear deck and beyond. There are three bedrooms, two on the lower level and the main on the top level. The main bedroom has direct access to the bathroom. You can treat it as an en-suite.

Queensland's hinterland living is more about the outdoors than the indoors and this home has an excellent covered, north-facing deck that adds to the inside living space and takes in the view.

Imbil is set on the banks of Yabba Creek and the edge of Imbil State Forest. It's the gateway to Borumba Dam. Gympie is less than half an hour from Imbil and, with the new freeway just 10 minutes away, it's an easy drive to anywhere from here.
